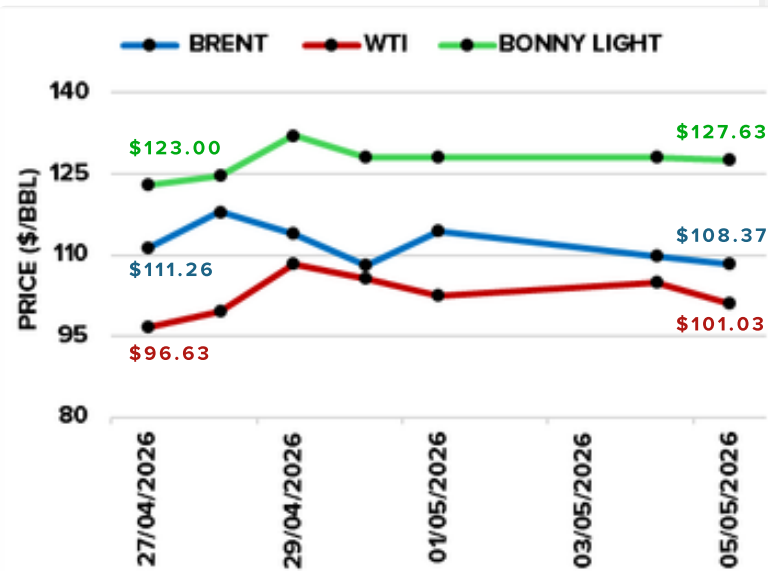
Market Summary

• Acc to S&P Global Update, State-run Nigerian National Petroleum Company Ltd. (NNPCL) said May 4 it has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with two Chinese firms for the completion of the overhaul of Nigeria's Port Harcourt and Warri refineries, as well as take up the operation and maintenance of the two facilities. Both the Old and the New Port Harcourt refineries, with a combined nameplate capacity of 210,000 b/d, and the 125,000 b/d Warri refinery remain offline after having operated in fits and starts in the past. 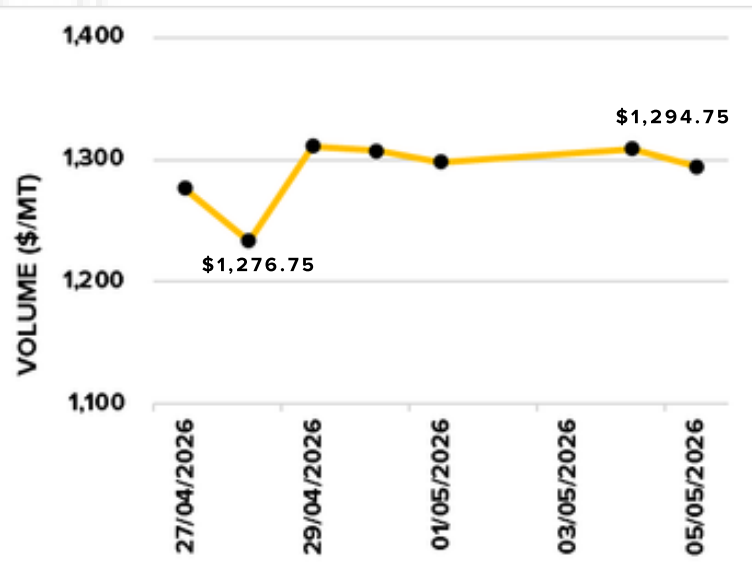
• The Naira experienced a slight depreciation of approximately ₦1.31, moving from 1,365.25 to 1,366.56. Despite the marginal daily drop, the Naira has appreciated significantly since the end of April. The rate improved from 1,374.94 on April 30 to 1,366.56 on May 5, representing a recovery of roughly ₦8.38 or 0.61%.

ICE Futures EUR.

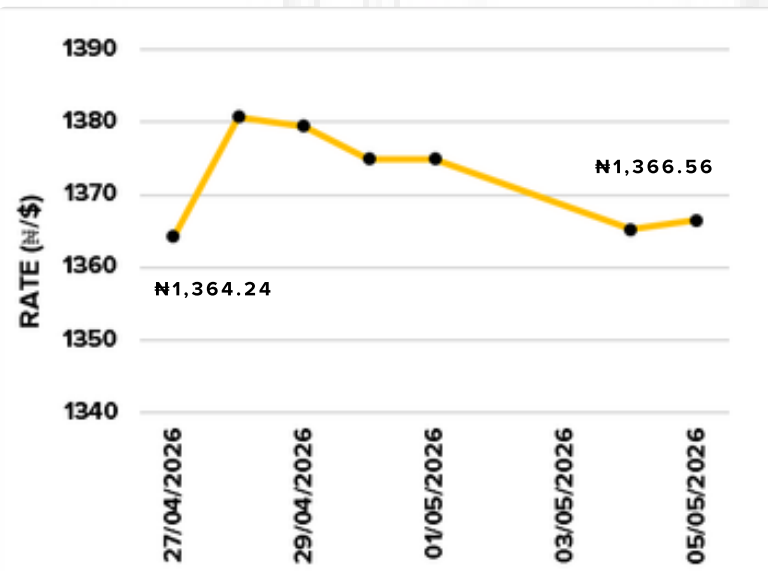
