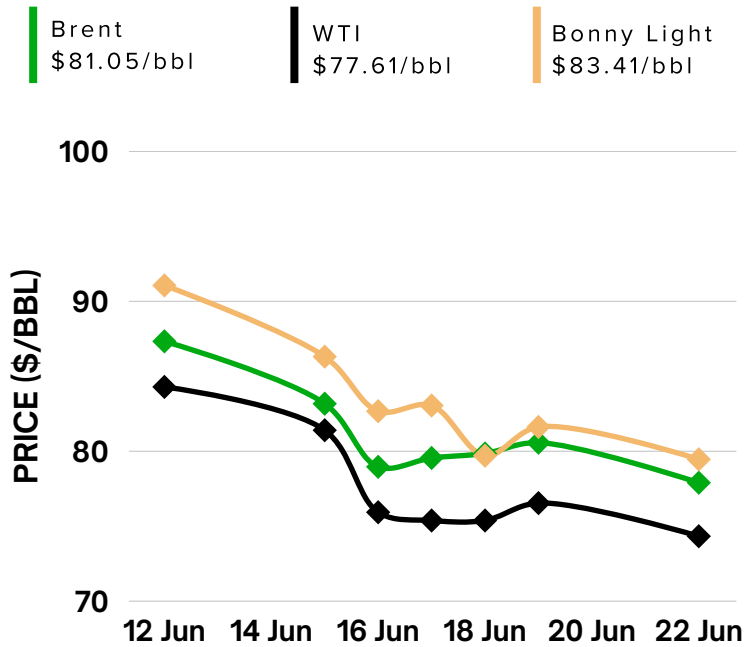

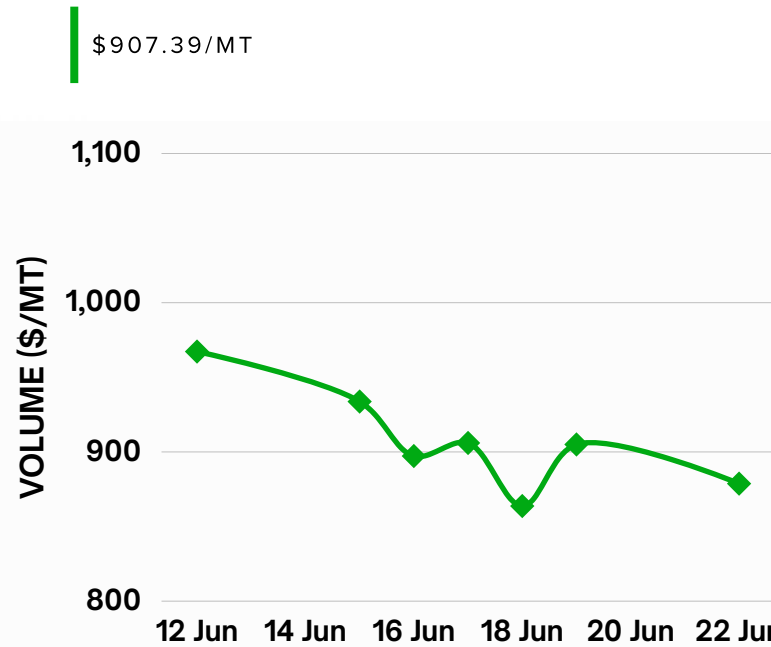
## Crude Benchmark
