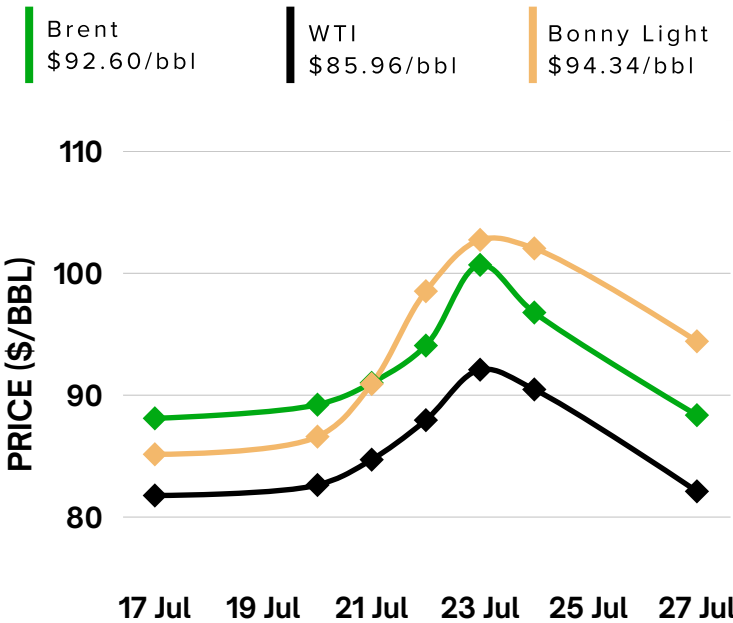

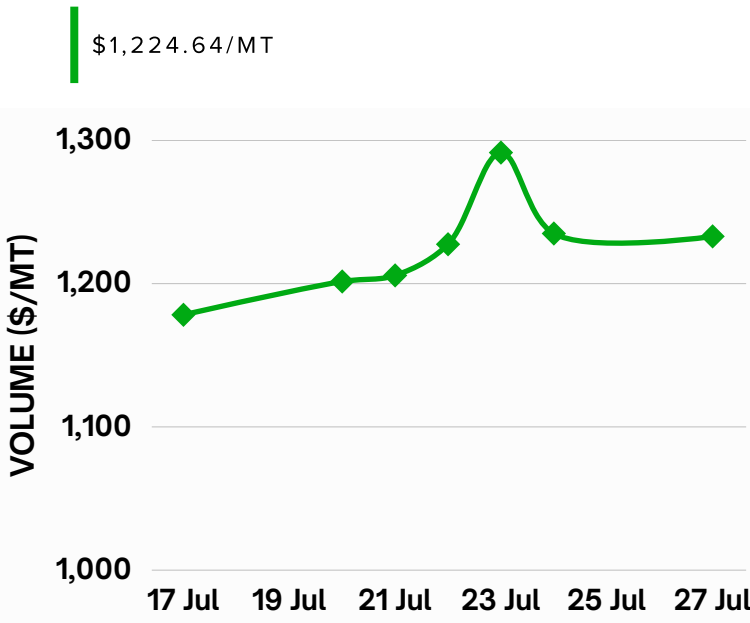
Crude Benchmark

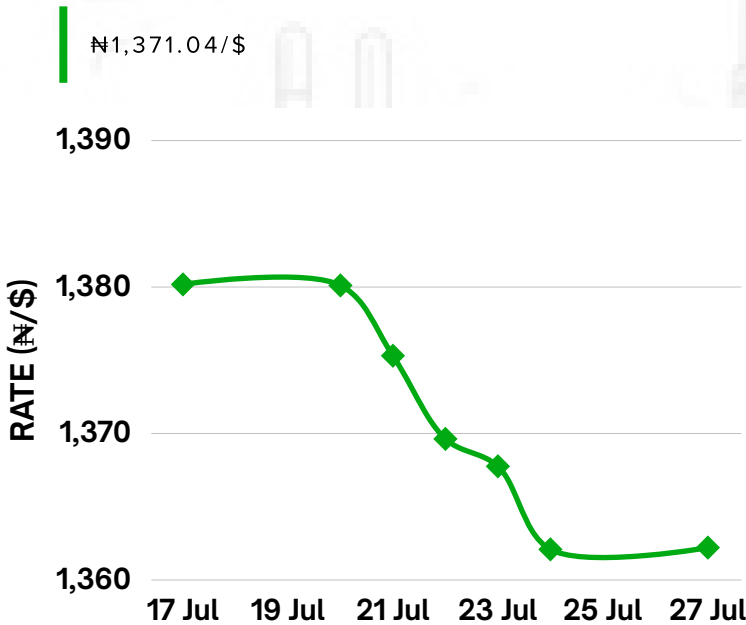

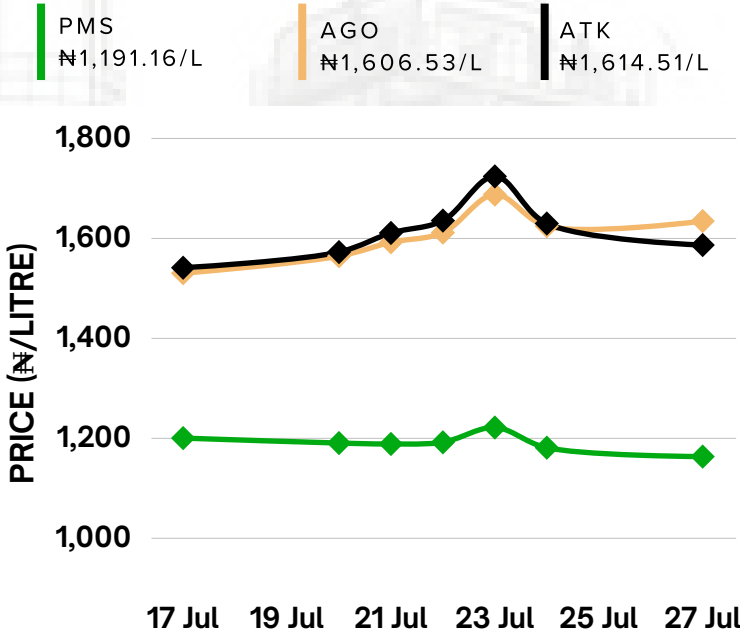
